

Lubbers' Landing

Important Travel and Arrival Information

Please print this form and retain for your reference.

To enter the Bahamas, you must have proof of citizenship: A passport for each person is preferable, however, you may also travel with a photo ID, such as a drivers' license, AND an official birth certificate with a raised seal until September 2008'. After that time a passport is required.

Check In is 2:00 on the day of your arrival. Please let us know your arrival time and flight information well in advance by E-mailing this information to info@lubberslanding.com along with your reservation number. **Sea Horse Boat Rentals closes at 5pm. If your flight arrives after 5pm you must let us know in advance so that we can arrange a late pickup.**

Check Out is 11:00 AM on the day of your departure.

Upon your arrival to the Marsh Harbour Airport, take a taxi into town, where we recommend buying a few groceries and any other supplies you may want, at least for your first day or so. Then, have the taxi driver take you to **Sea Horse Boat Rentals** in Boat Harbour Marina. Your boat will be waiting for you. Please call us before leaving the marina so that we can meet you on the dock at Lubbers' Landing. The Sea Horse staff will go of the boat with you, offer you insurance options, and show you the way out to Lubbers' Landing (about a fifteen minute trip).

**Please do not call us on the VHF radio as reception varies and we may not hear you from the island.*

Items to bring with you:

In the islands, dress is informal. Be sure to bring a flashlight! Also, sunscreen and we suggest a pair of water shoes for wading. Raingear is also a good idea. We recommend that you bring your own snorkel gear and fishing gear. Many discount stores carry name brand snorkel sets at reasonable prices. If you do choose to rent, call ahead to reserve your snorkel gear from one of several dive outfits in our area, which also offer many great dive trips. Quality fishing gear is not as readily available, so if you are into fishing, it is best to bring your own. Please see our website for more info and suggestions. Most of our guests tell us they brought way too many clothes and plan to bring fewer clothes, more gear & still travel lighter next time!

What we supply:

We furnish your bed linens , towels, shampoo, conditioner, bath soap, paper towels, toilet paper, and garbage bags. We supply the beach, **but please bring your own beach towels!**

What else we provide:

We are in the office every day to answer your questions. We keep you apprised of weather conditions and point you in the right direction should you need guidance during the week. Some cell phones will work here depending on the plan and roaming agreement with the Bahamas... you can call your phone company to find out before your arrival if you plan to bring your phone with you. We have wireless internet, so you can also bring your laptop, but don't plan on doing much work. (That's why it's called a "getaway"!)
